- 01.** 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for Petitioner and learned counsel for the State-Opposite Parties.
3. The present Writ Petition has been filed *inter alia* with the following prayer:-

“It is therefore prayed that this Hon'ble Court may graciously be pleased to It is therefore prayed that this Hon'ble court may graciously be pleased to;

i. Admit and allow the writ petition of the petitioner and issue notice to the Opp. Parties;

ii. After hearing the Parties, direction may be issued the Opp. Party Nos. 1 to 5 for giving promotion to the Petitioner in the rank of Manager from post of Asst. Manager in the Sambalpur DCC Bank Ltd. within time limit when his Junior, Opp. Party No. 6 was given promotion with all other consequential benefits including service and financial benefits.



iii. Direction may be issued to the Opp. Party Nos. 4 & 5 to issue Promotion Order in favour of the Petitioner to the rank of Manager when the Opp. Party No. 6 was given promotion as Manager and release the full salary within time limit.

AND

iv. To pass such other orders / directions as deemed fit and proper.

And for this act of kindness the petitioner shall remain duty bound ever pray."

4. In course of hearing, learned counsel for the Petitioner state that highlighting his grievances, the Petitioner has made a representation to Opposite Party No.2 vide Annexure-12 and the same may be directed to be considered within a stipulated time, to which learned Counsel for the State has no objection.

5. As agreed by learned counsel for the parties and after going through the records, this Court, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, disposes of the Writ Petition directing Opposite Party No.2 to consider the representation filed by the petitioner vide Annexure-12 in accordance with law within a period of three (3) months from the date of production of certified copy of this order.

Accordingly, the Writ Petition stands disposed of.
