1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.
2. Heard learned counsel appearing for the parties.
3. Petitioner has filed the present writ petition inter alia with the following prayer:-

It is therefore, most humbly prayed that this Hon'ble Court may graciously be pleased to:

- (i) Admit the writ application.
- (ii) Call for the records.
- (iii) Issue Rule NISI calling upon the opposite parties to show cause, why representation of the Petitioner has not disposed.
- (iv) Issue a writ in the nature of mandamus/or any other writ/writs, direction/directions be issued to count period of service from the date of joining on contractual basis instead of regularization.

And pass such other order/orders as would be deemed fit and proper
