1. Office note put up by the Registry dated 06.05.2025 indicates the following:-

“Notice on admission & stay matter issued to sole OP by Registered Post with AD returned undelivered on 29.04.2025 with Postal endorsement "Insufficient Address".

Also on computer verification it is found that no counsel has yet appeared on behalf of Opposite Party. I.A. No. 47 of 2025 is at flag "A" for further orders reg. stay.”

2. It is submitted by Ms. S. Patnaik, learned counsel for the petitioner that the address given in this petition is same as that mentioned in the appeal memo being MAT Case No.31 of 2024 filed under section 13A(ia)1(b) of Hindu Marriage Act, 1956, pending before the Senior Civil Judge,



Sundargarh. The address relied upon by the learned counsel for the petitioner is indicated here: “resident of village/P.O. Talcher, Dist. Angul, Odisha, at present residing at/P.O. Sonpur Dist. Sonpur, Odisha.”

3. The returned postal article bears the following address:-

“At/PO- Sonepur, Dist- Sonepur, Subarnapur.”

The suggestion is that such address is sufficient to send a postal article.

4. In considered opinion of this Court on the face of it, by simply mentioning the town and district without any further particulars, a person cannot be located by the postal authority to deliver a postal article. The petitioner has the obligation to provide the present correct address of the Opposite Party.

5. As prayed for, list on 30.06.2025. The detailed address shall be provided by the petitioner for issuance of notice afresh to the Opposite Party.

6. Interim order dated 07.03.2025 passed earlier shall continue till the next date of hearing.
