1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for appearing for the Parties.
3. The present Writ Petition has been filed *inter alia* with the following prayer:-

“It is therefore prayed that your Lordships' would be graciously pleased to direct the Opp. party No.1&2 for drawl and disbursement of Grade Pay of Rs.6600/- towards 3 MACP benefits w.e.f. 01.02.2023 and proper fixation of his pay in the new ORSP Rules, 2017 w.e.f.01.02.2023 as the petitioner joined in Govt. Service as a Steno S.I. of Police on 01.02.1993 and completed 30 years of continuous of service as on 31.01.2023 so also similar benefits has already been extended to other Police personnel under Annexure-3 &5 to the writ petition by the Opp. Party No-1;

and proper; AND/OR pass such other order/ orders deemed fit

And for this act of your Lordship's kindness the petitioners as in justice duty bound shall ever pray.”.

In course of hearing, learned counsel for the Petitioner states that highlighting his grievance, Petitioner has made a representation to Opposite Party No.2 vide Annexure-6 and the same may be directed to be considered within a stipulated time, to which learned Counsel for the State has no objection.

As agreed by learned counsel for the parties and after going through the records, this Court, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, disposes of the Writ Petition directing Opposite Party No.2 to consider the representation filed by the Petitioner vide Annexure-6 within a period of three (3) months in accordance with law from the date of production of certified copy of this order.

Accordingly, the Writ Petition stands disposed of.
