Order No. 07

1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and learned counsel appearing for the Opp. Parties.
3. Petitioner has filed the present writ petition inter alia with the following prayer:-

“It is therefore most respectfully prayed that, this Hon'ble Court may graciously be pleased to:-

A. Admit this writ application.

B. As to why the opposite parties more particularly opp. party no. 3 shall not be directed to release and disburse the retirement benefits like i.e., Arrear Salary, CPF deposit amount and other allowances in total to the tune of Rs.11,13,321/- along with accrued Interest @ 18% per annum since 2018 as has been directed by this Hon'ble court on dated 12.04.2023 under Annexure-5, and as per the order dated 06.09.2025 passed by the Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Odisha, Bhubaneswar, under Annexure-6, and,



C. And as to pass such other order or orders as this Hon'ble Court deem fit and proper.

And on their failure to show cause or showing in sufficient cause, this Hon'ble Court be pleased to make the said RULE absolute by way of issuing appropriate writ or writs, order or orders in the facts and circumstances of the present case.

And for this act of your lordships kindness the petitioner as in duty bound shall ever pray.”

4. However, taking into account the claim raised in the present Writ Petition, liberty is granted to the Petitioner to make a fresh representation before Opp. Party No. 3 by enclosing all the relevant documents and citations in support of her claim, if any, within a period of three (3) weeks hence.

5. It is observed that if such representation is filed within the aforesaid time period, Opp. Party No. 3 shall do well to take a lawful decision on the same within a period of three (3) months from the date of receipt of such representation. The order so passed by Opp. Party No. 3 be communicated to the Petitioner.

6. With the aforesaid observation and direction, the Writ Petition is disposed of.
