Sri Nagen Kumar Barik, learned Advocate for the petitioner submitted that though the land in question was transferred in favour of the petitioner way back in the year 1999 by way of registered sale deed, in the current settlement in the year 2014 the Record of Right has been prepared showing the status as *Abad Jogya Anabadi* in Government khata.

2. Challenging such wrong recording in the Record of Right, the petitioner has filed an application under Section 15(b) of the Odisha Survey and Settlement Act, 1958 before the Member, Board of Revenue which was registered as O.S.S. Case No.800 of 2025. It is the sole grievance of the petitioner that though the matter has been pending since 2025, till date the same has not yet been entertained.

3. Sri Sanjay Rath, learned Additional Government Advocate shall file affidavit sworn to by a responsible officer of the



Office of the learned Member, Board of Revenue, Odisha indicating as to why the matter has not yet been taken up for even admission on the next date of listing.

4. It is stated by learned Advocate that an application being I.A. No.4217 of 2026 has been filed for interim protection. The same is not placed on board today.

5. Registry is instructed to list the said I.A. along with aforesaid writ petition on the next date of listing.

6. Sri Barik, learned counsel for the petitioner undertakes to serve a copy of the said I.A. on Sri Rath, learned Additional Government Advocate in course of the day.

7. Liberty is granted to the counsel for the petitioner to make a mention, if exigency arises before the date of listing.

8. List this matter in the week commencing on 4th May, 2026.
