1. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.
2. Heard learned counsel appearing for the parties.
3. The present Writ Petition has been filed inter alia with the following prayer :

Under the above circumstances, it is humbly prayed that the writ petition may be allowed.

(A) a writ of Certiorari or an appropriate writ may be issued modifying the impugned order dated 06.12.2025 issued by the Tahasildar. Niali under Annexure: 5 by fixing the Grade Pay of the petitioner with effect from 01.01.2006 as Rs.4,200/- instead of Rs. 1900/- and 2nd ACP with effect from 28.12.2010 in the Grade Pay of Rs.4600/-instead of Rs.2000 and his promotional scale as Revenue Inspector with effect from 31.08.2010 in the Grade Pay of Rs.4600/- instead of Rs.4200/-and the differential arrears may be calculated and may be paid to him within a time to be stipulated by this Hon'ble Court;

(B) And or other any order /orders may be issued so as direction/directions to give complete relief to the petitioner;



4. In course of hearing, learned counsel for the Petitioner states that highlighting his grievances, Petitioner has made a representation before the Opp. party No.2 vide Annexure-6 and the same may be directed to be considered within a stipulated time, to which learned Counsel for the State has no objection.

5. As agreed by learned counsel for the parties and after going through the records, this Court without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, disposes of the Writ Petition directing Opposite Party No.2 to consider and dispose of the representation vide Annexure-6 to the Writ Petition, in accordance with law, within a period of three (3) months from the date of receipt of this order with due communication to the Petitioner.

6. With the aforesaid observation and direction, the Writ Petition stands disposed of.
