- 02.** 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical) Mode.
- 2.** Heard learned counsel appearing for the Parties.
- 3.** Pursuant to the order dtd.04.03.2026, learned Addl. Standing Counsel produced the instruction so issued by the Superintendent In-Charge, CHC, Bangurigaon in Court. The same be kept in record.
- 4.** Basing on the instruction, it is contended that Petitioner is being paid with his current salary.
