1. On 09.03.2026 the following order has been passed;

“1. This CRLMP has been filed with the prayer to direct the Opposite Party to make over / transfer investigation of the case to the competent parallel investigating agency in the State of Odisha, in the interest of justice.

2. Today, a memo signed by Mr. S.K. Samal, learned counsel for the Petitioner is filed stating that the Petitioner has taken back the case file and withdrawn consent as on 24.02.2026, for which the counsel has requested the Court to discharge them from further appearance in this case. The memo is taken on record. The same be scanned and incorporated in the digital record.

3. Mr. N.K. Das, learned counsel and his associates were engaged by the Petitioner. The Court has nothing to say about engagement or disengagement of the counsel. If the counsel does not want to continue in the case on the



ground of lack of instructions, it is open to the learned counsel to withdraw consent at their own risk, as he/they was/were engaged by the Petitioner. The Court can only note the submission of the counsel.

4. *In order to give one more chance to the Petitioner, list this case on 23.03.2026.*

5. *Registry to verify, if any, other counsel have appeared in this case on behalf of the Petitioner and indicate their names in place of the present counsel.”*

2. As per the report of the filing Assistant, no other counsel have filed appearance memo on behalf of the petitioner.

3. In view of the above, the CRLMP is dismissed for non-prosecution

4. It is open to the petitioner to file an application for restoration of the matter within three weeks from today.
