1. This matter is taken up through hybrid arrangement.
2. By filing the present CRLMC, the Petitioner has prayed for issuance of a direction to the learned trial Court i.e. learned J.M.F.C.-IV, Bhubaneswar to dispose of 1 C.C. Case No.2783 of 2025 within a stipulated time period.
3. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner.
4. After hearing learned counsel for the Petitioner and on perusal of the available materials on record, this Court is of the view that the prayer made by the Petitioner is not acceptable. This Court cannot issue a direction to the learned trial Court to dispose of the case within a stipulated time, as this Court is not apprised of the ground realities faced by the learned trial Court or the reasons for the alleged delay. Moreover, the case in question cannot be said



to be an inordinately delayed matter warranting such direction.

5. Accordingly, this Court is not inclined to interfere in the present CRLMC and the same stands dismissed.

6. However, it is observed that the learned trial Court shall make an endeavour to dispose of the said 1 C.C. Case as expeditiously as possible, in accordance with law.

7. Pending application (s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
