1. This matter is taken up through hybrid arrangement.
2. By filing the present CRLMC, the Petitioner seeks the following relief:

“In light of the aforesaid facts and circumstances this Hon’ble Court may be graciously pleased to admit the criminal miscellaneous case, call for the records from the concerned Police Station of Badachana Dist.- Jajpur, issue notice to the Opp. Parties Nos.1, 2, 3, and after hearing the parties be pleased to quash the FIR dtd. 19.10.2024 in the PS Case No.472 of 2024 against the present petitioner under Sections 115(2), 296, 3(5), 351(2) & (3), 85 of the BNS, 2023 and Section 4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961 on the grounds of mutual settlement as well as the unwillingness of the Complainant i.e. the Opp. Party No.4 from pursuing the said matter.



And in the interest of justice and equity your lordship may be pleased to direct the Badachana PS to submit the Closure Report U/S 193 of BNSS, 2023."

4. Issue Notice.

5. Learned counsel for the State waives notice on behalf of the Opposite Party Nos.1 to 3. Let three extra copies of the brief be served on her within three working days hence. She is directed to file reply within ten days from the date of receipt of the brief.

6. Notice be issued to Opposite Party No.4 by Speed Post with A.D. making it returnable by 9th March, 2026. Requisites for issuance of notice shall be filed within three working days hence.
