1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. The petitioner has approached this Court with the following prayer:-

*“It is therefore, humbly prayed that your lordships may graciously be pleased to admit this writ petition issue rule nisi in the nature of writ or nay other writs calling upon the Opposite Party particularly to O.P. No.4 to show cause as to why:-*

*1.The Mutation Case of the petitioner shall not be considered and after proper field inquiry considering the Mutation Case No.4 of 1970, under Annexure-2 series, the ROR shall not be published in respect of land of the petitioner?*

*And in the event of failure to show cause or show insufficient causes by the O.P.s the writ petition of the petitioner may be allowed and the Rule Nisi be made absolute:*

*And may further be pleased to pass any other order(s)/ direction(s) as this Hon'ble Court deem just fit and proper to the facts and the circumstances of the case:*

*And for this act of kindness the petitioner shall as in duty bound ever pray.”*

3. Since the petitioner claims correction of the record of rights, he has to file application for mutation before the appropriate authority. The writ application is therefore, disposed of granting



liberty to the petitioner to file application for mutation of the property in question through online mode within fifteen days from today. If such application is submitted, the concerned Tahasildar shall proceed in accordance with law.
