1. Heard Mr. S. Mohapatra, learned counsel for the Petitioner and Mr. G. Tripathy, learned Additional Government Advocate for the State-Opposite Parties.

2. Considering the limited grievance of the Petitioner that the authorities of the Bhubaneswar Municipal Corporation are proceeding for eviction and demolition of residential house of the Petitioner without granting her any opportunity of hearing, the writ petition is disposed of at the stage of admission with a direction to the Commissioner, Bhubaneswar Municipal Corporation, Bhubaneswar (Opposite Party No.4) to grant due opportunity of hearing to the Petitioner before proceeding for eviction of the Petitioner from the case land and take decision, in accordance with law, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order along with a copy of the writ petition. Till such decision is taken by Opposite Party No.4, status quo as on date in respect of nature and character of the case land shall be maintained.



3. An urgent certified copy of this order be granted on proper application.
