1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and learned counsel appearing for the Opp. Parties.
3. Petitioner has filed the present writ petition inter alia with the following prayer:-

*“Under the aforesaid facts and circumstances, it is therefore, prayed that this Hon’ble Court may graciously be pleased to:-*

*(i) direct/order the Opp Parties to modify the Order, dated 11.05.2021 as at Annexure-6 and thereby anti-date the regularization of the Petitioner w.e.f 20.9.1997 with all consequential financial and service benefits, for the interest of justice;*

*(ii) pass such other order(s) or issue direction(s) as may be deemed fit and proper in the bona fide interest of justice;*

*And for this act of kindness, the Petitioner as in duty bound shall ever pray.”*

4. However, taking into account the claim raised in the present Writ Petition, liberty is granted to the Petitioner to make a fresh representation before Opp. Party No. 2 by enclosing all the relevant documents and citations in support of her claim, if any, within a period of three (3) weeks hence.

5. It is observed that if such representation is filed within the aforesaid time period, Opp. Party No. 2 shall do well to take a lawful decision on the same within a period of three (3) months from the date of receipt of such representation. The order so passed by Opp. Party No. 2 be communicated to the Petitioner.

6. With the aforesaid observation and direction, the Writ Petition is disposed of.
