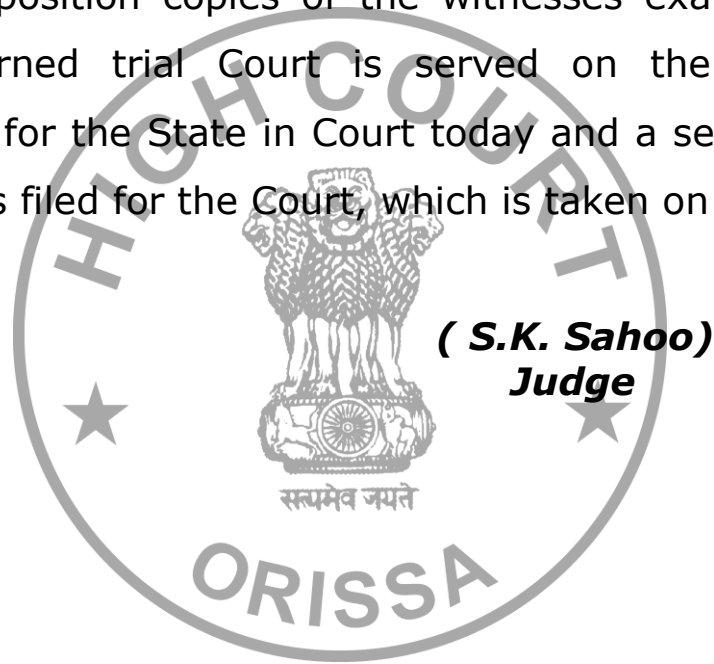
Call for the trial Court records.
