01. 1. This matter is taken up through hybrid arrangement.
2. In filing this CRLA, the Appellant has challenged the judgment of conviction and order of sentence dated 22.01.2026 passed by the learned Special Judge-cum-2nd Additional District & Sessions Judge, Baripada in G.R. Case No.96/2021 arising out Morada P.S. Case No.267/2021 (T.C. No.21 of 2022).
3. Heard.
4. Admit.
5. Issue notice.
6. Learned counsel for the State waives of notice on behalf of the Respondent No.1. Let an extra copy of the appeal memo be served on her within three working days hence.
7. Notice be issued to the Respondent No.2 by Speed Post with A.D. making it returnable by 22nd April, 2026.



Requisites for issuance of notice shall be filed within three working days hence.

8. List this matter on 22nd April, 2026 for final hearing.

9. Registry is directed to obtain soft copy/photocopy of the TCR in the meantime.

I.A. No.587 of 2026

10. Heard.

11. Considering the submission made on behalf of the Appellant and looking to the averments made in this I.A., this Court allows the prayer made in this I.A. Accordingly, realization of fine amount shall remain stayed till disposal of the appeal.

12. This I.A. is, accordingly, disposed of.

I.A. No.588 of 2026

13. In filing this I.A., the Appellant has prayed for releasing him on bail in G.R. Case No.96/2021 arising out of Morada P.S. Case No.267/2021 (T.C. No.21 of 2022) pending before the Court of learned Special Judge-cum-2nd Additional District & Sessions Judge, Baripada, Mayurbhanj.

14. Heard.

15. Learned counsel for the Appellant submits that the Appellant was all along on bail during course of trial and also on bail after pronouncement of impugned judgment.



16. Considering the submissions made on behalf of the Appellant and looking to the averments made in this I.A., this Court directs the Appellant to surrender before the learned court in *seisin* over the matter in the aforesaid case and move for bail within a period of fifteen working days hence. In such event, the said court shall release him on bail with some stringent conditions with further condition that he will never threaten the victim/informant in any manner. It is also made clear that violation of any of the conditions to be imposed by the learned court in *seisin* over the matter shall entail cancellation of the bail granted to the Appellant by this order.

16. This I.A. is, accordingly, disposed of.
