Issue emergent notice. Learned CGC-Mr. Bhokta, on request of the Court, accepts notice for O.P No.1. A copy of the writ petition with all the documents be served on him within three working days.

Notice be sent to Opp. Party Nos.2 & 3 by speed post making it returnable within two weeks, requisites for which shall be furnished within three working days.

Learned counsel for the Petitioner draws our attention to interim order dated 19.02.2026 granted in a similar case i.e. W.P.(C) No.5611 of 2026 between **Sapan Kumar Kandi v. Union of India** and therefore, his client should be granted similar benefit on the principle of parity, there being no repugnant factors. We agree.



In view of the above, the application in I.A. No.3767 of 2026 is disposed off granting interim protection to the Petitioner herein, as has been granted in the cognate case in Sapan Kumar Kandi *supra*.
