1. Mr. Mukherjee, learned senior advocate appears on behalf of petitioner and submits, prayer of his client to Court is firstly, regarding impugned demand dated 18th August, 2020 for Rs.3,83,857/- towards rent and GST, allegedly outstanding against his client as on 31st July, 2020. He submits, in the meantime his client's shop was demolished. Hence, the second prayer, for allotment of a shop from amongst those constructed in the vending zone in Odisha State Road Transport Corporation (OSRTC) bus stand at Badambadi, Cuttack.

2. Mr. Tripathy, learned advocate appears on behalf of opposite party nos.1 to 3 (OSRTC). None appears on behalf Cuttack Municipal

Corporation (CMC) though there has been good service on it having had been added as opposite party no.4 by our order dated 20th July, 2023. In the circumstances, we request Ms. Naidu, learned advocate, in the panel of CMC, to obtain instructions and assist us in adjudication of the writ petition.

3. Petitioner must demonstrate declaration of vending zone, in which petitioner wants allotment of shop.

4. Mr. Mukherjee prays for interim protection to extent that there be kept one shop vacant in Cuttack Netaji Bus Terminal, scheduled to be inaugurated day after tomorrow. In event there stands declared a vending zone in said to be inaugurated bus stand, a shop is to be kept vacant till next date of hearing.
