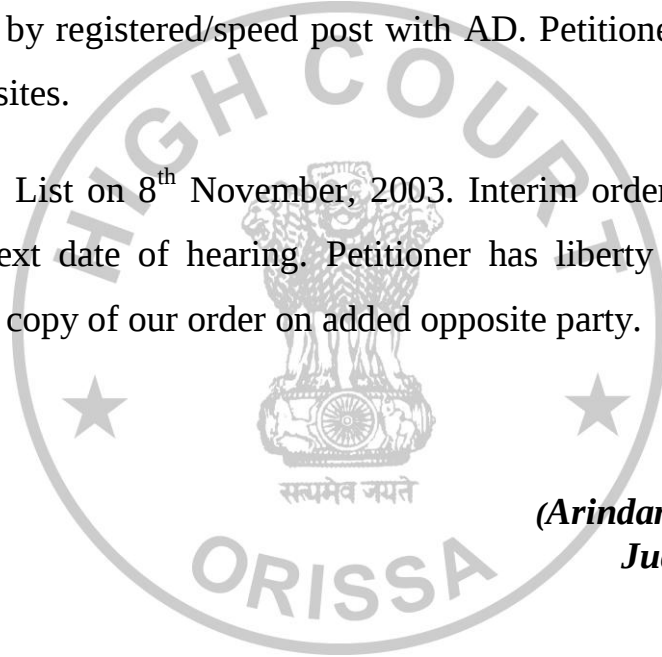

1. Mr. Mukherjee, learned senior advocate appears on behalf of petitioner and submits, his client is a stationary street vendor within meaning of clause (k) under definitions section 2 in Street Vendors (Protection of Livelihood and Regulation of Street Vending) Act, 2014. He submits, heretofore undisclosed stand has been taken in the counter that his client's shop was demolished allegedly being a public premises and order made in alleged ex-parte proceeding.
2. Mr. Tripathy, learned advocate appears on behalf of opposite party nos.1, 2 and 3. With reference to interim order dated 14th September, 2023 he submits, compliance is not

within control of his client since the newly constructed stalls are being dealt with by Cuttack Development Authority (CDA).

3. Cuttack Municipal Corporation (CMC) goes unrepresented. CDA is added as party. Petitioner has liberty to cause the amendment in Court, to be countersigned by the Court Master. Consolidated cause title be served on Mr. Tripathy. Issue notice along with this order on added opposite party by registered/speed post with AD. Petitioner will put in requisites.

4. List on 8th November, 2003. Interim order to continue till next date of hearing. Petitioner has liberty to forthwith serve copy of our order on added opposite party.
