Hence, the petitioners-appellants be admitted to bail by the trial court in T.C. No.129 of 2013/(V.G.R. No.30 of 2007) on such terms and conditions as it would deem just and proper till disposal of the criminal appeal.

Accordingly, the Misc. Case is disposed of.
