1. This CRLMP has been filed with the following prayer;
“In view of the facts and circumstances stated above, it is most humbly prayed that this Hon'ble Court may graciously be pleased to:
A. Issue a writ of Mandamus directing Opposite Party No.3 (Executive Magistrate-cum-Tahasildar, Raghunathpur) to forthwith exercise jurisdiction under Section 163 BNSS and pass appropriate preventive and restraining orders within a fixed time frame.
B. Direct Opposite Party No.4 (IIC, Raghunathpur Police



Station) to immediately submit the inquiry report as originally directed and not to defer compliance any further.

C. Direct the Superintendent of Police, Jagatsinghpur to ensure strict compliance of Magistrate's directions and maintain law and order at the spot.

D. Pass such further order(s) as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit in the interest of justice and to uphold rule of law.

And for this act of kindness, the petitioner, as in duty bound, shall ever pray.”

2. Mr. B. P. Routray, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in spite of order passed by the Executive Magistrate for submitting the inquiry report on 09.02.2026, the inquiry report has not been submitted by the IIC, Raghunathpur Police Station. He also submits that no written order has been passed by the learned Executive Magistrate, but he has endorsed on the petition filed by the petitioner directing the IIC to report on the breach of peace.

3. The copy of the order which the petitioner seeks compliance has not been filed with the CRLMP.

4. That apart the High Court is not the Executing Authority in respect of orders of the Executive Magistrate, Raghunathpur.

5. Hence, this Court is not inclined to entertain this CRLMP which is according dismissed.
