01. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical Mode).
2. Heard Mr. K.P. Mishra, learned senior counsel for the Petitioner as well as learned Additional Government Advocate for the State. Perused the writ application as well as documents annexed thereto.
3. By filing the present writ application the Petitioner seeks to challenge the conduct of the Opposite Party shall not



antedating the regularization of service of the Petitioner with effect from the date of his initial entry into the service.

4. Learned senior counsel appearing for the Petitioner in course of his argument referred to the letter dated 16.01.2026 at Annexure-10 and submitted before this Court that the Opposite Parties are insisting that the Petitioner is bound by undertaking pursuant to notification dated 13.01.2026. While challenging the decision vide letter dated 16.01.2026 at Annexure-10, learned senior counsel for the Petitioner contended that the Petitioner is not bound by the undertaking which is absolutely illegal.

5. On a careful consideration of the grievance raised by the present Petitioner, this Court observed that similar writ applications have already been admitted by this Court and the same are pending for final consideration. In such view of the matter, the matter requires further consideration along with similar other matters.

6. Since a copy of the writ application has already been uploaded in the LMS Portal. No hard copy is required to be served on the learned counsel appearing for the Opposite Party-State. Extra copy of the writ application be served on the DSGI.

7. List this matter in the week commencing 16.03.2026 along with other similar writ applications.
