04.        1.     This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/ Physical Mode).
2.     Heard learned counsel for the Petitioners and learned counsel appearing for the Opposite Party No.2-Informant.
3.     On perusal of the application it appears that the dispute involved in the criminal proceeding arises out of a matrimonial discord between the Petitioner No.1-husband and the Opposite Party No.2-Wife.
4.     This Court on a careful examination of the material is of the view that the dispute can amicably resolved through the mechanism



of mediation.

5. Learned counsels appearing for the respective Parties are requested to approach the learned Co-ordinator, Orissa High Court Mediation Centre for amicably resolution of the dispute through the mechanism of mediation. On their appearance along with the copy of today's order the learned coordinator shall appoint a trained mediator to resolve the dispute. Parties are directed to cooperate with the mediator for an amicable and early settlement of the dispute. Copy of the mediation report be sent to this Court by the next date.

6. List this matter in the week commencing 22<sup>nd</sup> September, 2025.

8. As an interim measure it is directed that on an application being filed by the petitioners seeking adjournment, the learned trial court shall do well to adjourn the matter for a period of eight weeks.
