05. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid mode.
2. Although the mediation report filed before this Court reveals that the attempt at mediation has failed, however taking into consideration the nature of the dispute involved in this case, this Court is of the view that the same can very well be resolved with the help of the learned counsels appearing for both sides.
3. Learned counsel appearing both sides extended their consent to give it another try through the mechanism of mediation.
4. Learned counsel for the Opposite Party No.2-wife contended that since the Opposite Party No.2-wife is ailing the mediation



should take place at the District Mediation Centre at Ganjam, Berhampur. Learned counsel for the Petitioners has no objection to such proposal.

5. Taking into consideration such consent of the parties, the parties are directed to once again approach the learned coordinator of the District Mediation Centre Ganjam, Berhampur along with a copy of today's order within ten days from today. On their appearance learned coordinator shall appoint a trained and experienced mediator to resolve the dispute between the parties.

6. Further this Court directs that the Petitioner No.1 shall pay initially Rs.25,000/- to the Opposite Party No.2-wife which shall be taken into consideration by the learned trial court while adjudicating the application for interim maintenance.

7. List this matter in the 1st week of February, 2026. A report of the learned mediator be placed before this Court by the next date.

8. Interim order passed earlier shall continue till the next date.
