1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner. Peruse the CMP application as well as the prayer made therein.
3. Being aggrieved by the order dated 19.02.2026 passed in Civil Revision No.4 of 2025 passed by the learned A.D.J, Salipur, thereby confirming the order dated 03.12.2025 passed by the learned Civil Judge (Jr. Division), Salipur in Civil Suit No.3 of 2025, the Petitioner has approached this Court by filing the present CMP application.
4. Learned counsel for the Petitioner at the outset contended that the learned Revisional Court has held that the order rejecting the application under Order-7 Rule 11 is an interlocutory order and not a final order disposing the suit. Therefore, no revision lies.
5. Considering such submissions, this Court is of the view that



the matter requires further consideration in presence of the Opposite Parties.

5. Hence issue notice to the Opposite Parties-Plaintiff by Speed Post with A.D., by fixing a short returnable date. Requisites be filed within three working days.

6. List this matter in the week commencing 30th March, 2026.
