1. Heard Ms. D. Mohapatra, learned counsel for the Petitioner and Mr. T.K. Dash, learned Additional Government Advocate for State-Opposite Parties.

2. It is submitted on behalf of the Petitioner that without granting any opportunity of hearing, the Tahasildar is proceeding for eviction/demolition of the Petitioner by issuance of general notice dated 05.02.2026 (Anneuxre-5).

3. Accordingly, the writ petition is disposed of at the stage of admission with a direction to the Tahasildar, Berhampur, Dist.-Ganjam (Opposite Party No.3) to grant due opportunity of hearing to the Petitioner before proceeding for eviction/demolition and take a decision, in accordance with law, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order along with a copy of the writ petition. Till such



decision is taken by Opposite Party No.3, status quo as on date in respect of the case land shall be maintained by the parties.

4. An urgent certified copy of this order be granted on proper application.
