- 1.** This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.
- 2.** Heard learned counsel for Petitioner and learned counsel for the State-Opposite Parties.
- 3.** The present Writ Petition has been filed *inter alia* with the following prayer:-

“It is therefore, humbly prayed that this Hon'ble Court may graciously be pleased to:-

(i). Direct the opp. parties to sanction pension and pensionary benefits in favour of the petitioner taking into consideration his long 31 years of regular service having GPF Account No. SEO 9450 and GIS within a stipulated period as may be fixed by this Hon'ble court;

(ii). Pass such other order (s)/direction(s) as would be deem fit and proper in the bona fide interest of justice;



And for which act of kindness, the petitioner as in duty bound shall ever pray.”

In course of hearing, learned counsel for the Petitioner state that highlighting his grievances, the Petitioner has made a representation to Opposite Party No.2 vide Annexure-10 and the same may be directed to be considered within a stipulated time, to which learned Counsel for the State has no objection.

As agreed by learned counsel for the parties and after going through the records, this Court, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, disposes of the Writ Petition directing Opposite Party No.2 to consider the representation filed by the petitioner vide Annexure-10 in accordance with law within a period of three (3) months from the date of production of certified copy of this order.

Accordingly, the Writ Petition stands disposed of.
