1. This CRLMP has been filed for a direction to the Opposite Party No.4- the IIC, Jajpur Police Station to register the FIR, investigate the matter and take appropriate action against the accused persons as per law.

2. Mr. J. Behera, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that FIR was submitted by hand to the IIC, Jajpur Police Station on 04.12.2024. Thereafter, since FIR was not registered, after more than one year, a representation was addressed to the DSP, in-charge, Jajpur Police Station on 04.02.2026. There is neither any endorsement on Annexure-1 and 2 regarding submission/receipt of the two documents nor is there any averment/document to indicate that this complaint had been sent to the concerned officer by registered post/speed post.



3. In view of non-compliance of the provisions of Section 173(4) of the BNSS, I am not inclined to entertain the CRLMP, which is accordingly dismissed.

4. At this stage, the petitioner wants to withdraw the CRLMP. Since, the matter has already been dismissed, the prayer for withdrawal is not entertained.
