1. Mr. D.R. Barik, learned counsel points out that on account of typographical / computer editing error, (i) in the last line of first paragraph of the prayer portion, the words “*cyber fraud*” and (ii) in the second paragraph, the words “*steps to secure the recovery of the duped amount and return the funds to the Petitioner*” have been mentioned by mistake and may be ignored.
