1. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that even though pursuant to the impugned order dated 19.02.2026, petitioner had not been relieved but on coming to know that a Writ Petition has been filed and this Court issued notice on Opp. Party No.2 by Special Messenger vide order dated 11.03.2026, petitioner was relieved vide order dated 13.03.2026.
3. It is contended that since on coming to know that a writ petition has been filed challenging the impugned order, petitioner has been relieved vide relieve order dated 13.03.2026 so enclosed to the I.A., the same reflects the malafide intention of the Opp. Party-Corporation.
4. Learned counsel appearing for the Corporation on the other hand contended that he has no instruction on the issue.
5. Considering the submission made, this Court is inclined to stay the impugned order of transfer issued on 19.02.2026 so far as it relates to the petitioner and so also the relieve order dated 13.03.2026. Opp. Party-Corporation is directed to allow the petitioner to continue in the place he was there prior to his transfer till the next date.
