The essential grievance of the Petitioner, who happens to be mortgager-debtor is against long pendency of SA No.40 of 2025 and also I.A. No.1133 of 2025 filed therein for restoration of possession.

2. Learned counsel for the Petitioner submits and we agree that right to speedy justice avails even in the proceedings that pend before the Tribunals like the DRT.

3. Notice to other side is dispensed with, since prayer is innocuous, and that they would have opportunity of opposing the matter when taken up by the DRT. We also keep open all contentions of the parties.

In the above circumstances, this Petition is disposed off requesting the DRT to take up the subject SA and also IA No.1133 of 2025 as the case may be expeditiously, preferably within a period of six (6) months excluding the adjournments sought for by the Petitioner.
