

05. 19.07.2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned Additional Government Advocate for the State.

Petitioners in this case having been implicated in C.T. Case No. 523 of 2018 (arising out of Nayapalli P.S. Case No. 59 of 2018) pending in the Court of learned S.D.J.M., Bhubaneswar for alleged commission of offence punishable under Sections 307/354-B/147/148/341/294/323/325/506/149 of IPC, have filed this petition anticipating arrest.

In view of the nature of allegations against the petitioners and taking into consideration the submissions made, it is directed that if the petitioners surrender before the court in seisin over the matter within four weeks hence and move application for bail, the Court concerned shall release them on bail in connection with the aforesaid case on such terms and conditions as it deems just and proper.

However, it is made clear that if any graver offence is found against the petitioners during the investigation in this case, besides the aforesaid offences, this order shall not be given effect to.

The ABLAPL is disposed of accordingly.
