1. The I.A. has been filed by the petitioner for correction of typographical error. It is submitted by the learned counsel that inadvertent typographical error has crept into the order dated 18.03.2026, wherein though at paragraph-1, 'CP No.48 of 2026' has been correctly mentioned in paragraphs-6 and 7, the same has been mentioned as 'Criminal Proceeding No.48 of 2026'.

Accordingly, it is directed the said order shall be corrected as per the procedure.

2. Free certified copy of the corrected order shall be provided to the petitioner as the petitioner has already obtained certified copy of the order dated 18.03.2026.



3. It is further submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that due to inadvertent typographical error in paragraphs-6 and 7, though paragraph-1 indicates case number correctly, the learned Family Court has not entertained the affidavit of the petitioner and also has not allowed prayer for adjournment.

The certified free copy of the corrected order shall be provided to the petitioner immediately.

4. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that next date of posting of CP No.48 of 2026 is 05.05.2026. On the said date, the matter shall be adjourned upon a prayer being made for the said purpose beyond 18.05.2026 to a date as would be convenient to the learned court in seisin of the matter.

5. It is submitted that after the order dated 18.03.2026 has been communicated to the learned trial court, though the paragraph-1 clearly mentions CP No.48 of 2026 somehow the learned trial court was not considerate enough to consider the same, has proceeded in the matter further and has posted the matter for arguments.

6. It is directed that the stage of the proceeding before the learned trial Court for all purpose shall be as on 18.03.2026, in view of this Court having passed interim order on 18.03.2026.

7. Copy of this order as well as the corrected order dated 18.03.2026 shall be forwarded by the Registry to the learned Judge, Family Court, Jajpur to be kept in



the records of CP No.48 of 2026. Copy of both the orders shall be served on the learned for the petitioner and the petitioner himself through the office of the learned Judge, Family Court.

8. Office note indicates that the postal tracking report indicates postal envelope containing the notice has been served on the opposite party on 13.04.2026. No counsel has appeared on behalf of the opposite party.

9. Awaiting appearance of the opposite party, the matter shall be listed in the week commencing 18.05.2026.
