- 1.** This is an interlocutory application for bail filed by the Appellant/Petitioner.
- 2.** Heard Mr. Rajib Bihari Mishra, learned counsel appearing for the Appellant/Petitioner, Mr. Partha Sarathi Nayak, learned Additional Government Advocate appearing for the State and Mr. Nitin Kumar Pradhan, learned counsel appearing for the Informant/Victim.
- 3.** Mr. Partha Sarathi Nayak, learned State Counsel has



produced the conduct certificate and custody certificate of the Appellant/Petitioner-Sanjaya Nayak and written instruction dated 08.07.2026 relating to the criminal antecedent against him received from the Inspector in-charge, Raikia, Police Station, which is taken on record.
