The Petitioner by filing this application under Section 430 of BNSS prays for suspension of execution of sentence imposed upon him for the conviction recorded under Section 357(3) of Cr.P.C. by the learned SDJM, Udala in C.T Case No. 291 of 2019 corresponding 1.C.C. No.06/2019 and his release on bail pending disposal of this Criminal Revision.
