01. 1. This CRLMP has been filed for proper and impartial investigation of Bandar Marine P.S. Mr. Sarathi Jyoti Mohanty, learned Additional Standing Counsel produces the instructions dated 21.03.2026 of the I.I.C., Bandar Marine Police Station where it is stated that after completion of investigation, the I.O, ASI, Biswajit Bardhan has submitted charge sheet No.34 dated 29.12.2025 under Section 126(2), 296, 115(2), 351(3), 3(5) of BNS.

4. Since alternate remedy is available to the Petitioner, if he is aggrieved by the charge sheet, the CRLMP is disposed of without issuing any direction, but granting liberty to the Petitioner to avail the alternate remedy which is available to him under law, if so advised.
