01. 1. This CRLMP has been filed for a direction to the learned JMFC, Binka to dispose of 1.C.C. No.4 of 2025.
2. Perusal of the order sheets in 1.C.C. No.4 of 2025 pending in the Court of learned JMFC, Binka, which has been annexed under Annexure-3 to the CRLMP reveals, the complaint was filed on 11.03.2025 and the case had been adjourned to 18.03.2025, on which date the complainant was directed to remain present on 26.03.2025 for recording of his initial statement, but the complainant was absent on 26.03.2025. Thereafter, on 08.04.2025, his initial statement was recorded and



he had been directed to bring his witnesses for inquiry under Section 202 of the Cr.P.C. on 23.04.2025. But, on dated 23.04.2025, 14.05.2025, 24.06.2025, 24.07.2025, 12.08.2025, 12.09.2025, 14.10.2025 and 14.11.2025, the learned counsel for the complainant was present, but the complainant and/or his witnesses were absent, for which the case was adjourned.

3. In view of the conduct of the petitioner, I do not consider this to be a fit case to issue any direction to the learned JMFC, Binka for expeditious disposal of 1.C.C. Case No.4 of 2025.

4. This CRLMP is accordingly dismissed.
