01. 1. It is submitted by learned counsel appearing for the petitioner that the writ petition was filed seeking a direction upon the authorities to dispose of the application for shifting of the shop from the existing place to a proposed site. In the meantime, the petitioner has received an order rejecting the said application and, therefore, it constitutes a fresh cause of action.
2. In view of the above fact, the instant writ petition has become infructuous and, accordingly, the same is dismissed. However, dismissal of the instant writ petition shall not prevent the petitioner from challenging the order of rejection before the appropriate forum.
