- 01.** 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for Petitioner and learned counsel for the State-Opposite Parties.
3. The present Writ Petition has been filed *inter alia* with the following prayer:-

“It is therefore most humbly prayed that this Hon'ble Court may graciously be pleased to:-

1) Admit and allow the case;

ii) Call for the records

iii) Issue Rule NISI calling upon the opp. Parties as to why the impugned order v ide Annexure-5 dated 27.1.2026 in letter No. 1027 issued by the Opp. Party No. 3 shall not be quashed with an order to absorb the petitioner in the post of Computer Programmer on promotion w.e.f. 27.01.2026 as per Annexure-6 and in case the opp. Parties are fail to make counter or insufficient counter, make the rule absolute by issuing any Writ or writ in nature of



iv) To direct the opp. party No 2 to consider the representation followed by the petitioner vide Annexure-4 only with a view to give promotional post as Computer Programmer to the petitioner as per Annexure-1

And pass any order/ order(s) direction/direction(s) in favour of the Petitioner as deemed fit.

And for which act of kindness, the petitioner shall as in duty bound, ever pray."

4. In course of hearing, learned counsel for the Petitioner states that highlighting his grievances, the Petitioner has made a representation dated 21.07.2025 before Opposite Party No.2 vide Annexure-4 and the same may be directed to be considered within a stipulated time, to which learned Counsel for the State has no objection.

5. As agreed by learned counsel for the parties and after going through the records, this Court, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, disposes of the Writ Petition directing Opposite Party No.2 to consider the representation dated 21.07.2025 filed by the petitioner vide Annexure-4 in accordance with law within a period of three (3) months from the date of production of certified copy of this order.

Accordingly, the Writ Petition stands disposed of.
