1. This CRLMP has been filed for a direction to the Joda Police Station, Keonjhar for registration of the FIR.

2. The allegation in the complaint is that the Petitioner is the registered owner of a 12 wheeler tanker bearing Registration No. OD05BV 0189. On 18.02.2026, the tanker was loaded with diesel from Paradeep Nayara Energy Limited, C/o- Indian Oil Corporation Ltd., Paradeep to be supplied to Jitendranath Pattanaik, Baneikala, Joda, Keonjhar. But on the way the driver sold about 815 litre diesel. This was detected by the petrol pump staff so the owner of the petrol pump intimated this theft to the Company and the Petitioner. The driver and helper fled after leaving the tanker in the



petrol pump premises and all efforts to contact the driver Tapan Jena failed as his mobile was switched off. The Company has issued notice to the Petitioner for blacklisting the tanker permanently.

3. A memo signed by Mr. Debasish Patnaik, learned counsel for the Petitioner is filed today, contents of which are extracted below:-

*“The Petitioner do not want to proceed in this case
show the above matter may kindly be withdrawn.”*

The said memo is taken on record. It shall be scanned and incorporated in the digital record.

4. In view of the memo signed by Mr. Debasish Patnaik, learned counsel for the Petitioner, the CRLMP is dismissed as withdrawn.
