01. 1. This CRLMP has been filed for a direction to the Opposite Party No.2 to take up the investigation in a fair and unbiased manner in Chandrasekharpur P.S. Case No. 681 of 2025 corresponding to C.T. Case No. 1873 of 2025 pending in the Court of the learned J.M.F.C.-II (Cog-taking), Bhubaneswar.
2. Mr. Ashok Kumar Apat, learned Additional Government Advocate produces the instructions dated 23.03.2026 of the ASI, Chandrasekharpur Police Station, Bhubaneswar, Khurda, it is stated as follows:-

“During Course of investigation examine the complt.and other witnesses and recorded their statement recorded U/S-180 BNSS. Visited the



spot and prepare spot map in CDF Examined the accused persons and as prima facie evidence U/s-126(2)/296(b)/351(3)/318(4)/3(5) BNS well made out against the accused persons namely Pradip Kumar Senapati (55) S/o-Debendra Nath Senapati of A/4, Palasapalli, Ps-Airport, Dist-Khurda BBSR and Sunita Senapati(53) W/o-Pradip Senapati of A/4, Palasapalli, Ps-Airport, Dist-Khurda BBSR. With due discussion with my IIC issued notice U/S-35(3) BNSS to both the accused persons Seized one bag containing 1.Laptop (HP SI no.5CD237FZCF,model name RTL 8822 CE.2.3nos of Cheque book and one pass book (Axis Bank in the name of Bijay Goldar Account no.922010048280961, Pass book SBI in the name of Kumudini Goldar Account no.38000129896, Indian Bank, Bijay Goldar Account no.50012410296,one unnamed SBI Cheque book. One Black colour gym bag containing one iPhone. Two wrist watch of brand make BVLGARI, make Patek Philippe, yellow metal looking like gold solid bracelet and 3 links of looking like gold, one black colour money purse containing one driving license in the of Bijay Goldar Two Pan card pertaining to Bijay Goldar one Indian Bank insta card no.6080239775030756, one Axis Bank Debit Card no.4691970071378020,one Indian Bank Debit card no.5085362027017640, one Aadhar Card in the name of Bijay Jena Aadhar no.913787913770, Two Indian Bank cheque book pertaining to Bijay Goldar Account no.50012410296 in presence of witnesses and prepared seizure list. Left the same in zima to the complt. after executing proper Zimanama. The case is pending for supervision



and submission of C.S. against the accused persons.”

3. Mr. R.K. Das, learned counsel for the Petitioner submits that the items which have been mentioned in the instructions to have been seized by the Police and zima of which has been given to him, have not been seized in connection with the present case. He further submits the Petitioner was running a Bar under a valid licence in the premises. He had spent a huge amount of money for renovating and furnishing the premises from which he was illegally ousted by the accused persons in gross violation of the agreement. Liquor, furniture, bar and restaurant equipment etc. were there in the premises which the accused persons have not returned. But they have let out the premises to another person or rent to ruin a Bar and utilize the articles which belong to the Petitioner.

4. As details of the articles have not been mentioned in the CRLMP, and perusal of the instructions reveals that the investigation is still under progress, the CRLMP is disposed of granting liberty to the Petitioner to avail the alternate remedy which is available to him for recovery of his articles which were left in the premises.
