This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.

- 2.** Heard learned Counsel for the Petitioner.
- 3.** Though it has not been pleaded in the transfer petition, learned Counsel for the Petitioner submits that the Petitioner is a physically handicapped person and is unable to attend the day-to-day proceeding before the learned Judge, Family Court, Bhubaneswar. She being a deserted lady, is also not financially affluent to meet the travelling as well as legal expenses to be incurred by her and engage a lawyer at Bhubaneswar. However, learned Counsel for the Petitioner undertakes to file an Affidavit to the said effect within a week hence.
- 4.** Issue notice on admission and stay to the sole Opposite Party by Speed Post with A.D. fixing a short returnable date, indicating therein that the matter is likely to be disposed of at the stage of admission. Requisites be



filed within a week hence along with the Affidavit, as undertaken. Copy of the Affidavit shall form part of the notice to be sent to the Opposite Party.

**5.** The matter be listed before the regular Bench having assignment in the week commencing from 27<sup>th</sup> April, 2026 along with tracking report of notice to the Opposite Party.

**6.** As an interim measure, further proceeding in Civil Proceeding No.841 of 2025, pending in the Court of learned Judge, Family Court, Bhubaneswar is stayed till the next date.

**7.** Urgent certified copy of this order be granted as per rules.
