1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid mode.
 2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioners. Perused the CMP application as well as the prayer made therein.
 3. By filing the present application under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, the plaintiff-Petitioners in CS No.370 of 2022 pending before the learned Civil Judge, Kendrapara have approached this Court for a direction to the learned trial court to expedite the trial and to conclude the same as expeditiously as possible.
 4. Taking into consideration the submissions made by learned counsel for the Petitioners and considering the nature of the prayer, this Court is of the view that no specific direction would be given by this Court at this stage. Considering the fact that the learned trial courts are over-burdened with year-old suits which are pending for trial. However, taking into consideration the nature



of the dispute involved in the present CMP application, liberty is granted to the Petitioners to move the learned trial court by filing an appropriate application with a prayer for early disposal of the suit subject to the convenience of the learned trial court, the learned trial court shall pass necessary orders thereon.

5. With the aforesaid observations/ directions, the CMP application stands disposed of.
