1. This matter is taken up through hybrid arrangement.
2. Heard learned counsel for the Appellant and learned Additional Standing Counsel for the State.
3. This application has been filed for grant of bail to the Appellant.
4. Taking into account the submissions made and on going through the averments taken in the application; this Court is not inclined to release on bail to the Appellant. However, this Court direct that the Appellant be released on interim bail for a period of **3 (three)** months reckoning from the date of his actual release by the learned Adhoc Additional District and Sessions Judge,



(FTSC), Jajpur in C.T. Spl. (POCSO) Case No.161 of 2019 on such terms and conditions as deemed just and proper by the court in *seisin* over the matter with further conditions that;

- i. The Appellant shall appear before the local Police Station on every Sunday between 10 A.M. to 1.00 P.M. during the period of interim bail.
- ii. the Appellant shall not enter into the boundary of the village of the victim.
- iii. The Appellant shall not threaten or cause any kind of inconvenience to the victim or the family members of the victim;

Violation of any of the above conditions shall lead to cancellation of the interim bail.

5. The Appellant shall positively surrender before the court in *seisin* over the matter as would be so directed by the said Court on expiry of period of interim bail.
6. The I.A. is accordingly disposed of.

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7. List this matter on 23rd June, 2026 for final hearing.

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8. Heard.
9. There shall be stay on realization of fine imposed against the Appellant vide judgment dated 04.03.2024 passed by the learned



Adhoc Additional District and Sessions Judge, (FTSC), Jaipur in
C.T. Spl. (POCSO) Case No.161 of 2019 pending finalization of the
Criminal Appeal.

10.The I.A. is accordingly disposed of.
