2. The present writ petition has been filed by the petitioner to explore the following relief:

“to admit this writ petition and issue a rule NISI, calling upon the O.Ps. to file show cause as to why the prayer of the petitioner shall not be granted, if the O.Ps. fail to file show cause or give insufficient cause your Lordship’s would be further pleased to make the rule absolute and issue an appropriate writ. Further direction be given directing to the O.Ps. No.2 to 6 to examine the correctness of allegations and after finding at the truth direct the O.Ps. to stop the brothel or every day prostitution, to prevent performance of immoral Acts, to oust the O.P. No.7, to arrest her according to the F.I.R. and forward her to the Court.”

3. The present writ petition is pending since 04.04.2019. The Stamp Reporter has pointed out the



defect regarding the inappropriate nomenclature, which has not yet been cured by the learned counsel for the petitioner.

4. In view of the aforementioned, the writ petition stands dismissed.
