01. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid mode.
2. On the prayer of the learned counsel for the Petitioner, he is permitted to add Union of India represented through the Principal Secretary, Department of School Education and Literacy, Government of India as Opposite Party No.3 to the present writ petition.

Let the consolidated cause title be filed within three working days.

3. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner. Perused the writ petition as well as the prayer made therein.



4. Challenging the action of the Opposite Parties in not permitting the Petitioner to discharge his duties, the Petitioner has approached this Court by filing the present application.

5. Learned counsel for the Petitioner at the outset contended that pursuant to an advertisement at Annexure-1 the Petitioner participated in the recruitment process and on being selected he was engaged as a mess helper. However, the Opposite Parties are not permitting him discharge his duties. Being aggrieved by such conduct, the Petitioner has approached this Court by filing the present writ petition.

6. Two extra copies of the writ petition be served on any of the learned Central Government Counsels, who shall obtain instruction by the next date.

7. List this matter in the week commencing 13.04.2026.
