02. 1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. Learned counsels of both the sides are present.
3. This Contempt Petition has been filed by the petitioner against the alleged contemnor on the ground for non-implementation of judgment dated 26.02.2026 in W.P.(C) No.9875 of 2016.
4. The said judgment passed on dated 26.02.2026 in W.P.(C) No.9875 of 2016 has not been varied, set aside or altered as yet and when, that judgment has not been declared as against the law, then, in view of the dictum of the Hon'ble Apex Court in a case between *Tata Mohan Rao vrs. M. Venkatswaralu and others* : reported in *2025(4) Civil Law Judgments(S.C.)-297* that, nobody including the alleged contemnor should be permitted to disobey the Court's direction and when, the



learned Standing Counsel for the State sought for seven days time to say about this matter, then, as per the submissions of the Standing Counsel for the State, this Contempt Petition be listed two weeks after.
