3. It is stated at the Bar that during the pendency of the appeal, the Petitioner has deposited a sum of Rs.2,00,000/-.

4. Considering that the compensation amount in question is amounting to Rs.10,00,000/-, it is directed that on depositing a further sum of Rs.1,00,000/-, the realization of fine imposed by the learned SDJM, Nayagarh, in 1CC No.63 of 2019 (TR No.222 pf 2024) shall remain stayed till disposal of the Criminal Revision.

5. Mr. Dwibedi, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the Opposite Party submits that the amount of Rs.2,00,000/- is lying in deposit.

Considering that there is no presumption of innocence so far as the Petitioner is concerned, it is directed that the amount Rs.3,00,000/- shall be released in favour of the complainant which shall be subject to the final outcome of the lis.
