 of the petitioner that, despite this court vide its order dated 25th

 hearing granted to the petitioner.



5. As an interim measure, it is directed that status quo as on date in respect of nature and character of the case land, i.e. IDCO Shed No.39 to 42 and 51 to 54, corresponding to Revenue Plot No.1397(P) and 1402(P) under Revenue Khata No.487 shall be maintained till 30th April, 2026.
