1. Recorded the submissions of learned counsels for the respective parties.
2. Instant contempt petition is filed by the petitioner for non-compliance of the Court's order at Annexure-1.
3. By order dated 19th September, 2024 in W.P.(C) No. 22967 of 2024, this Court had directed the opposite parties to consider regularization of the petitioner in the light of the order in W.P.(C) No.20939 of 2022 but it was followed by a decision dated 17th October, 2024 declining the same on the premise that the petitioner was an outsourced employee. Since such a decision has been arrived after considering the representation of the petitioner and there is compliance, this Court is inclined to drop the contempt proceeding however, granting the liberty to the petitioner to challenge the decision availing remedy under law.



4. Consequently, the CONTC stands disposed of.
